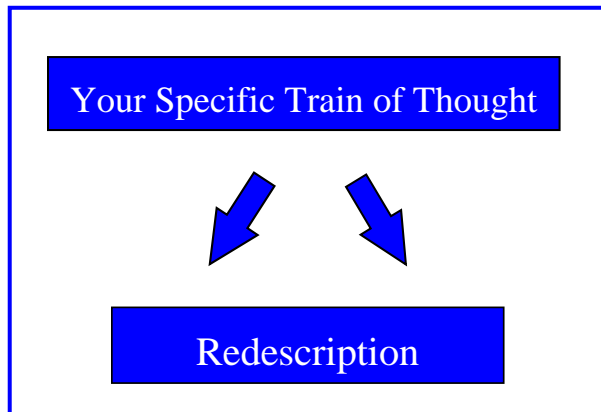


Step 2 - Redescription

We have stated our train of thought as specifically as possible. It is...

"A line of metal, cog shaped links sewn into one side of a fabric that can connect and disconnect with a pulled conjoining device to a matching system on another fabric."



Now we want to move to describe the same train of thought in a more general fashion. If this were a camera, we would be "panning out" to view our circumstance from a wider point of view. We want to do the same thing with words.

Important to note, when we are thinking of the specifics of our train of thought, our thinking is still "inside the box."

Our redescription efforts save the essential elements of our specific train of thought. "Metal" can be redescribed as solid or durable. "Cog shaped" can be replaced with connectors. The essence of "connect and disconnect" is repeatable. "Pulled conjoining device" can be redescribed as interlocking.
